



Locum Tenens

The Department of Psychiatry at Dalhousie University is recruiting a Locum Tenens for a 12 –month term to be the lead physician in an adolescent intensive services day and residential program. Adolescent Intensive Services (AIS) offers intensive mental health services in a multidisciplinary team setting for adolescents 13 up to 19 years of age.

Child and adolescent psychiatry qualifications and/or experience is preferred, but adult psychiatrists with experience in treating adolescents will be considered for this position. All applicants must be eligible for medical staff privileges with the IWK Health Centre and specialist licensure in psychiatry with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Nova Scotia.

The IWK is an academic tertiary care health centre for children, women and families in the Maritime Provinces. The Division of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry at Dalhousie University is one of the largest academic groups in Canada. Under new leadership, it is a growing division with several exciting innovations underway. The department also provides teaching and research through its affiliation with the Faculty of Medicine at Dalhousie University.
